



Dual Credit Scholarship Application

- Ellis County Students -

In addition to the attached scholarship application form, the following documents are required:

- 1) Completed Navarro College dual credit application,
- 2) Official high school transcript,
- 3) TAKS scores (if applicable) and/or Accuplacer scores showing eligibility for college classes,
- 4) Typed essay of 300 to 500 words by the student explaining the student's need for assistance and current educational and career goals, and
- 5) Letter of recommendation by a high school official.

Students must complete a personal interview with the scholarship committee in order to be considered, and they must have a minimum high school grade point average of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

The scholarships will pay for tuition and fees for up to two classes per semester, per student. Textbooks are not included. These scholarships are renewable for up to four semesters, as long as the student is still in high school and his/her college grade point average remains at a 3.0 or better.

Incomplete applications and applications without all required paperwork will not be accepted. Applications for the fall 2009 semester must be submitted by 5 p.m., June 15, 2009. Applications for the spring 2010 semester must be submitted by 5 p.m., Oct. 15, 2009. Please submit all documents to:
